

“Stay Safe, Stay Connected.”

This was our message to partners just days after the COVID-19 pandemic hit.

This program outlines what JSAV is doing to protect health, mitigate risk, and produce events during this re-opening and recovery period ahead.

Employee Health

Employees exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 will remain or return home. While at work, employees who notice a coworker or guest exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 will immediately contact a manager. At a minimum, all JSAV employees will follow [CDC Guidelines](#) for employers and businesses, including instructing employees to self-isolate for the required amount of time, as defined by the CDC.

Hand Cleaning

All employees will follow [CDC Guidance](#) regarding hand washing. Employees will wash their hands for at least 20 seconds, or use sanitizer when a sink is not available.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

CDC recommendations along with federal and local government regulations will dictate appropriate PPE to be worn by employees. PPE, along with appropriate training for use and disposal, will be made available to any employee upon request. Please refer to [OSHA](#) for more information.

Social Distancing

JSAV employees will follow [Social Distancing](#) best practices as recommended by the CDC along with federal and local government regulations.

Event Space

JSAV Employees will follow recommended [Social Distancing Protocols](#) while in any public areas including the event or meeting space. While setting equipment in meeting rooms, employees must keep a safe recommended distance and wear all recommended PPE for their location.

Property Policies
